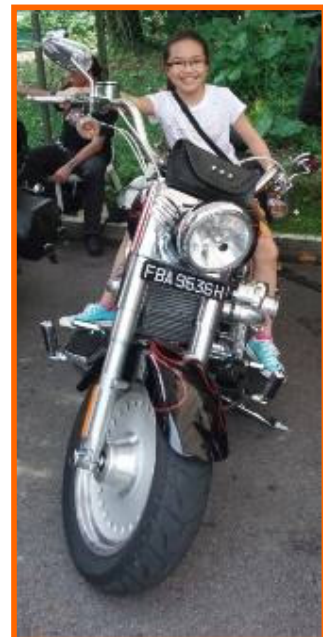


and last but not least, Philip Seow who arrived at lunchtime and kindly provided all of us with drinks and snacks.
